

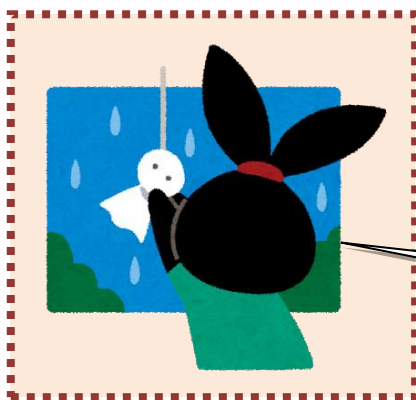

Oshaberi Salon

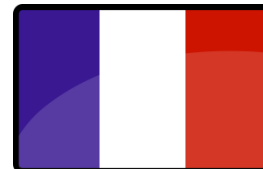

PSA: When to Call 118

Call 118 to report an accident or crime at sea to the Japan Coast Guard. If there is an incident, accident, or suspicious activity out in the sea, call 118 and calmly explain what happened, where, and when. Examples of when to call 118 include:

- You see oil floating in the sea
- There is a suspicious boat/ship
- You have information about smuggling
- There has been an accident (ie. someone drowning) in the sea
