
Flu and COVID-19 Vaccines

Elderly people are at risk of severe symptoms if they become sick with the flu or COVID-19. Those who wish to get vaccinated are encouraged to do so as soon as possible. You can be vaccinated for both at the same time.
When: October 1, 2024 – March 31, 2025
Eligibility for financial assistance: 1 People ages 65 or older (2) People ages 60-64 with a Level 1 Physical Disability Certificate who have a heart, kidney, or respiratory condition, and people ages 60-64 with immune

system disorders due to HIV

Vaccination site: Eligible facilities designated by Niigata City (see website for a list) **Individual cost**: <u>Flu</u>: ¥1,650; <u>COVID-19</u>: approx. ¥4,000 (varies by vaccine type)

*Free for households receiving public assistance (livelihood protection) Contact: Public Health Center TEL: 025-212-8123
